## The Fruits of Labor

As we pause to celebrate Labor Day, may we not forget that such a day was earned through the efforts of thousands of our union predecessors.

At the height of the Industrial Revolution in the late 19<sup>th</sup> Century, workers - both adults AND children - were working long hours for low wages in dangerous working conditions. This prompted them to join together and form unions to change these things. Since that time, unions have made monumental progress on these fronts. Among these efforts was the passage of a key piece of legislation called the 1938 Fair Labor Standards Act. This was a major win for labor as it established the 40-hour week (and weekends!), minimum wage and overtime, limits on child labor, and the ability to negotiate health and benefits plans. Thus, Labor Day became a day of celebration for the workers and an official Federal holiday in 1894.

And it wasn't just factory workers who united. association was taking root at the same time, officially commencing on May 25, 1903, as seen in the photo of the Cumberland Times News article of that date, and which makes us 120 this year!

We are part of this legacy and are charged to continue to be diligent for our students, profession, and public education. There are many opportunities to get more involved with ACEA, such as joining your building representative team, or serving on various committees, where you would help generate and direct the initiatives for our association. 


